Extra-Curricular Activities

DRAMA

Now in its ninth season, the St. Mary's Drama Club is the most participated-in program the school offers. Students are involved in all aspects of the production, from singing, dancing, and acting, to sets, props, costumes, and stage crew.

FAITH IN ACTION

St. Mary's Faith In Action Committee is responsible for the spiritual life of St. Mary's. Faith In Action promotes service opportunities throughout the school, sponsors the annual Christmas Door Decorating Contest, and much more. Most importantly, FIA coordinates the Sophomore/Junior/Senior Retreat in March each year, helping students to actively live their faith.

YEARBOOK

The St. Mary's Yearbook Club offers students the opportunity to work together as a team to create the school's yearbook. Through fundraising events, weekly meetings, and a strong dedication to preserve the exciting memories of St. Mary's year in and year out, the Yearbook Club provides a unique and valuable experience for all students involved throughout the school year.

MATHLETES/MATH CLUB

Math Team is for grades 9-12 and participates in the Worcester County Math League. Math Club is for grades 7-9, where students do math games & puzzles as well as work on competition style questions.

HONOR SOCIETY

Honor Society is open to those students in grades 8-12 who maintain a 90 or better academic average and perform community service for the school as well as the larger community. Honor Society greatly assists in the marketing and service activities of the school.

BOWLING CLUB

As members of the Worcester County High School Bowling Conference, the club participates in matches against 10 different schools weekly during the winter season at Auburn AMF Lanes.

CHEMISTRY CLUB

The chemistry club which is known as the Mole Society is affiliated with the American Chemical Society which provides us with monthly activities and resources. The club sponsors many activities. We also participate in the Coins for Cleaner Water

Initiative where we collect coins during Lent to buy water purification packets which are distributed to children and families without safe drinking water. The club meets monthly on Wednesday afterschool.

BOOK BUDDIES

Grades K-2 and High School. High school and elementary students spend 45 minutes in our Elementary School Library. Students pair off and explore the wonderful world of reading. Older students read to, coach, and share their love of reading. Younger students have strong, solid role models to look up to. Bonds are made and lasting friendships are built.

CHORUS

St. Mary's Choir is in its third season, and is a dedicated group of vocalists who enhance the school's liturgical celebrations. The Choir performs at all Masses and Lenten Stations of the Cross, as well as at the Pep Rally and school Talent Show.

YOUTH AGAINST HOMELESSNESS

The Youth Against Homelessness Club works to provide St. Mary's Junior Senior High School a way to stay informed about current housing issues in Massachusetts, and work to improve the lives of those affected by homelessness here in Worcester. We host fundraising events, awareness campaigns and clothing drives throughout the year.
