Extra-Curricular Activities

DRAMA

Now in its ninth season, the St. Mary's Drama Club is the most participated-in program the school offers. Students are involved in all aspects of the production, from singing, dancing, and acting, to sets, props, costumes, and stage crew. This is open to grades 4-12.
