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### **Dual Enrollment - St. Mary's Schools and Assumption College**

Assumption College is pleased to offer dual enrollment for juniors and seniors of the Saint Mary's School of Worcester, providing college credit for a passing grade on courses taken. **Furthermore Assumption College will not charge tuition for college credit for students in this program, provided that all of the following guidelines are met.**

#### **Number of Courses:**

- Students may take one course per semester, up to a total of two courses per student. At total number of 6 student course placements in all may be given per academic year (e.g. 6 students will take one course each or 3 students taking two courses each). This number is the total for both juniors and seniors.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 to enroll in courses at Assumption College
- A guidance counselor must provide a written letter of recommendation for a student, explaining why the student is qualified to take college-level courses in the subject desired.
- Students must be a high school junior or senior enrolled at the Saint Mary's School of Worcester.
- Only traditional undergraduate courses may be taken
- Students will be responsible for the cost of books and paying any course-related fees and any transcript fees.

**Registration**

- Registration information, including dates, will be provided to the guidance office
- Enrolment will depend in space availability
- High school students may begin enrolling before add/drop, but after regular Assumption College students
- Students must meet the prerequisites (if any) for any courses taken.

**Students Subject to College Policies and St. Mary's Schools polices:**

- Students are expected to adhere to the Assumption College academic calendar for Assumption courses, and are not excused from classes when Saint Mary's School classes are not in session.
- Students accepted for this program are assumed to be prepared to attempt college level courses and are therefore expected to function in the classroom setting exactly as Assumption College students. This means adherence to the requirements of the professor's syllabi and the policies of the Assumption College Student Handbook.
- Students cannot be late or miss classes at St. Mary's Schools due to a scheduled class at Assumption College with our prior authorization by St. Mary's Schools administration.

**Academic Support:**

- The services of the Academic Support Center will be available to students in this program
- Students may also attend the office hours of their professors for individual assistance

**Course Credit:**

- All courses with a passing grade will count for high school credit and Assumption College credit.
- Semester courses will count as a full honors credit at St. Mary's Schools.
